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SECTION II - INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

2.1 Scope of Pre-qualification

- 2.1.1 The TANA WATER WORKS DEVELOPMENT AGENCY hereinafter referred to as the procuring entity intends to pre-qualify candidates for registration for Supply and Delivery of Surgical Face Masks.
- 2.1.2 It is expected that the applications will be submitted to be received by the procuring entity not later than **WEDNESDAY 19TH MAY 2021 AT 10.00AM.**
- 2.1.3 Pre-qualification is open to eligible firms as indicated in appendix to instructions to candidates.

2.2 Submission of Application

- Applications for pre-qualification shall be submitted in sealed envelopes marked with the P.Q. name and reference number and deposited in the pre-qualification box at Tana Water Works Development Agency offices at Maji House, Baden Powell Road, addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, Tana Water Works Development Agency, P.O Box 1292-10100 Nyeri so as to be received on or before WEDNESDAY 19TH MAY 2021 AT 10.00AM to be opened after seven (7) days on 27th May 2021 at 10.00a.m;
- 2.2.1 TANA WATER WORKS DEVELOPMENT AGENCY reserves the right to accept or reject late applications.
- 2.2.2 The name and mailing address of the applicant **SHALL NOT** be marked on the envelope.
- 2.2.3 All the information requested shall be provided in the English language.
- 2.2.4 Failure to provide information that is essential for effective evaluation of the applicant's qualifications or to provide timely clarification or substantiation of the information supplied may result in the applicant's disqualification.

2.3 Eligible Candidates

- 2.3.1 This invitation for pre-qualification is open to all candidates who are eligible as defined in Kenya's Public Procurement Law and regulations and as indicated in the appendix to instructions to candidates.
- 2.3.2 The procuring entity's employees, committee members, board members and their relatives (spouse and children) are not eligible to participate in the pre-qualification unless where specially allowed under section 131 of the Act.

2.3.3 All firms found capable of performing the contract satisfactorily in accordance to the set pre-qualification criteria shall be considered.

2.4 Qualification Criteria

2.4.1 Pre-qualification will be based on meeting the minimum requirements to pass in the criteria set as shown below. The declaration will be either pass or fail regarding the applicant's general and particular experience and financial position as demonstrated by the applicant's response in the forms provided in Section IV and submitted with the letter of application. The procuring entity reserves the right to waive minor deviations if they do not materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract.

2.4.2 Qualification Criteria. (See appendix 1)

2.4.3 Litigation History

The applicant should provide accurate information on any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts completed or under its execution over the last five years. A consistent history of awards against the applicant or any partner may result in failure of the application.

2.5 Public Sector companies

2.5.1 Any public owned enterprise IS NOT eligible to qualify if, whether in addition to meeting all the above requirements, it is also legally and financially autonomous, it operates under commercial law, and it is not a dependent agency of another public entity.

2.6 Conflict of Interest

2.6.1 The applicant shall not be associated, nor have been associated in the past, with the consultant or any other entity that has prepared these documents. Any such association must be disclosed and may result in the dis-qualification of the applicant.

2.7 Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices

- 2.7.1 The Procuring entity requires that bidders observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process and execution of contracts when used in the present regulations, the following terms are defined as follows;
 - (i) "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution; and
 - (ii) "fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the Procuring entity, and includes collusive practice among tenderer (prior to or after

- tender submission) designed to establish tender prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the Procuring entity of the benefits of free and open competition;
- 2.7.2 The procuring entity will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the tenderer recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.
- 2.7.3 Further a tenderer who is found to have indulged in corrupt or fraudulent practices risks being debarred from participating in public procurement in Kenya;
- 2.7.4 The surgical face masks to be supplied shall be disposable medical Masks of such a quality and specification/s as may be described by the Procuring entity.

APPENDIX TO INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

Notes on the Appendix to the Instruction to Bidders

- 1. The Appendix to instructions to candidates is intended to assist the procuring entity in providing specific information in relation to the corresponding clause in the instructions to the candidates included in Section II and has to be prepared for each specific procurement.
- 2. The procuring entity should specify in the appendix information and requirements specific to the circumstances of the procuring entity, the goods to be procured and any criteria/s that will apply for pre-qualification.
- 3. In preparing the Appendix the following aspects should be taken into consideration;
 - (a) The information that specifies and complements provisions of Section II to be incorporated
 - (b) Amendments and/or supplements if any, to provisions of Section II as necessitated by the circumstances of the goods to be procured to be also incorporated
- 4. Section II should remain unchanged and can only be amended through the Appendix.
- 5. Clauses to be included in this part must be consistent with the public procurement law and the regulations.

The following information regarding the particulars of the documents shall complement supplement or amend the provisions of the instructions to the bidders. summary of actual assets and liabilities for the last five years.

This form is to be completed by all applicants including each member. It should provide information on any history of litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts executed in the last five
