Tana Water Works Development Agency (TWWDA) is a State Corporation established under the Water Act 2016 in the Ministry of Water & Sanitation and Irrigation. TWWDA covers five (5) counties of Nyeri, Kirinyaga, Embu, Tharaka-Nithi and Meru. The mandate of the Agency is to undertake the development, maintenance and management of the National Public Water Works within its area of jurisdiction.

In line with the need to realize the above mandate the Agency is seeking to recruit suitable and qualified persons to fill the following position whose holder will be based at TWWDA's Headquarters in Nyeri.

1. Manager Engineering, Asset Management, Liaison and Capacity Development – TWWDA Grade 3 - TWWDA/MAMLCD/6/2024

Terms of Service: Permanent and Pensionable

a) Job Purpose

The job holder is responsible for coordinating, overseeing, executing and assisting in all technical and matters related to asset management, liaison and capacity development to county governments and water service providers so as to ensure access to safe water to all stakeholders in the Agency Area.

b) Key Duties and Responsibilities

- i. Liaising with County Governments and Water Services Providers as appropriated;
- ii. Carrying out periodic assessment of water and sewerage infrastructure;
- iii. Ensuring water and sanitation infrastructure operate optimally;
- iv. Coordinating acquisition of way leaves, land and crop compensation;
- v. Implementing resettlement action plans (RAP).
- vi. Mapping, Developing and maintaining a database of water works related assets;
- vii. Operating, Maintaining and managing National Public Water Works and Sanitation within area of jurisdiction;



- viii. Operating Water Works and providing water services as a Water Service Provider as mandated by Section 68 (b) of the Water Act; 2016;
- ix. Providing reserve capacity for purposes of providing water services as per section 68 (c) of the Water Act; 2016;
- x. Providing Technical Services and Capacity Building to County governments and Water Service Providers as may be requested;
- xi. Ensuring project branding;
- xii. Preparing work plans and budget for the division; and
- xiii. Supervising project team & Performance appraisal of staff in the division

c) Person Specification
